Margarene's early childhood life was happily spent on the spacious and open fresh-air farm of her beloved grandparents (Mack & Hettie) who nourished her with a strong belief in family and her Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ as her Savior. From there she traveled and worked in Cleveland, Ohio, moving to the Arundel Public Schools System in the school district of Glen Bernie, Maryland, until her retirement in 2004, giving her a total of 35 years of serving children and all mankind.

Margarene's passion, love and concern for others were demonstrated by joining the Usher Board Ministry and other auxiliaries during her tenure at Reid Temple AME Church. Her active participation in church allowed her to become a solid marcher on to Zion to visit the city of God.
