The years she served her church family, the leadership she gave to her community, the 36 years of educating students, and the priceless knowledge she unselfishly shared with her family will never be forgotten. Her daughters, Tammy Peele Fussell and Angela Peele Grantham will be more than appreciative to carry on her legacy through this educational scholarship. On January 15, 2021 Mary Carolyn Reaves Peele went home to be with her father in Heaven. She passed away peacefully surrounded by her daughters and was welcomed by her late husband of 52 years, Edward Slade Peele, III. Mary, the oldest of 12 children was born on June 7, 1936 to the late Clinton Reaves and Rosie Reaves in Martin County. She became the “second” mom to the family and was affectionately known as “The Judge”. She matriculated through the Everetts school system and attended WC Chance High School. She furthered her education at Elizabeth City State University receiving her degree in Elementary Education and then earned her Master’s Degree in Education from North Carolina Central University in Durham. She taught elementary education for 36 years in Martin County, spending most of her teaching at East End Elementary, touching the lives of over 1000 s

tudents. She loved working with children and helping people in any way she could. Mary was as a role model and inspiration to everyone, with a great ability to meet anyone “wherever they are.” She was a very classy lady as well as a detailed planner. Mary was also a fantastic cook – feeding our souls in many different ways. She joined Saint Mark Church of Christ, Disciples of Christ at an early age and continued her membership there until death. Her heart longed to be able to be in attendance again. She held many positions and was a great leader in the church with roles as mother of the church, church secretary, treasurer, and trustee while also being in charge of committees like The Young Women Auxiliary and chairperson for several years of the Annual Homecoming Committee. Mary Carolyn was also active in her community as a member of the Robersonville Planning Zone Board, Retired Teachers Association, teacher associations NCAE/NEA, charter member of the SL Club – a women’s social, W.C. Chance High School Alumni, and Elizabeth City State University Alumni. She became the endearing matriarch of her family, always leading by example and a great storyteller – “Disney had nothing on Mary Carolyn.” Mary Carolyn married the love of her life, Edward Slade Peele, III in December 1959. To this union two daughters were born, and her role of a mother then blossomed. She was very proud of her girls as she poured all her wisdom and life experiences into nurturing and shaping her own. Later she became a grandmother to three wonderful grandboys. She always said, “I had the girls and my girls had the boys.” She was preceded in death by her sisters and brothers, Willie Reaves, Hilton Reaves, Carrie Jones, Marie Reaves, and Vivian Reaves. Mary Carolyn leaves to carry on her legacy her two daughters, Tammy Peele Fussell of West Chester, Ohio and Angela Peele Grantham (Anton) of Zebulon, NC; three grandsons, Jeremiah and Jayden Grantham, and Joshua Fussell; bonus family - Jerry Fussell, Jessica Tucker, and Jerry Fussell Jr; two sisters, Jean Rahman (Naeem) of Robersonville, NC and Dorothy Howard of Robersonville, NC; four brothers, Abdul Kareem Muhammad (Kareemah) of Newark, NJ, Kenneth Reaves of Raleigh, NC, Larry Reaves (Malinda) of Robersonville, NC, and Tim Reaves (Renea) of Knightdale, NC; two special guardianship nieces, Raychelle Baptist (Al) of Durham, NC and Kimberly Willis (John) of Butner, NC; a very special longtime best friend, Mary Raynard of Robersonville, NC and a host of nieces, nephews, in-laws from the Peele Family, cousins, and friends.
