Reverend Alphonza Little, Jr. the son of the late Alphonza Little, Sr. and Magaret Little was born in Martin County, April 13, 1941. He was educated in the Martin County Public Schools. At an early age he accepted Christ as his personal savior and joined Cedar Hill Missionary Baptist Church where he served as an usher, junior deacon, and then was called to preach his initial sermon. He was a faithful pastor at New Fellowship Baptist Church until his health failed.

On Tuesday morning, June 27, 2017 at 4 o'clock an angel of peace entered Roanoke River Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Williamston, NC and released from suffering, Reverend Alphonza Little, Jr.

He was preceded in death by one brother, Sonny Little; one sister, Alevis Reddick; one grandson, Alexander Little.

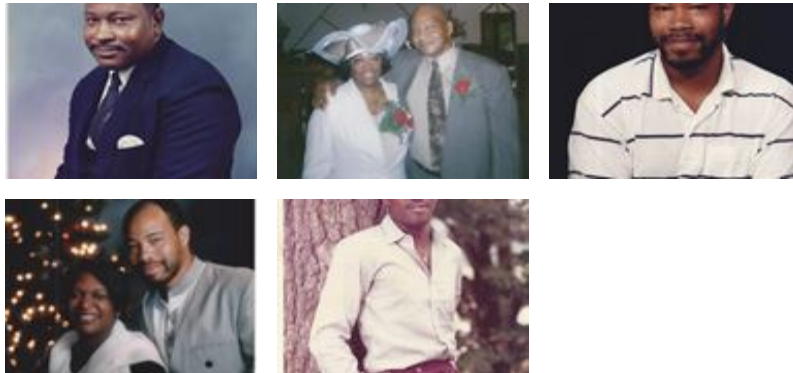
