Leroy loved giving people an encouraging word, he loved praising God, talking about God, and you could not tell Leroy that he was not a preacher because he would get around family and friends and preach his heart out, telling someone about a man called Jesus. Leroy knew the word, and learned how to live by them. One of Leroy's favorite song was "I'm Just a Nobody, Trying to Tell Everybody, About Somebody, Who Can Save Anybody". This was indeed, Leroy's great mission that he fulfilled until God called him home.

Leroy had a heart of gold. He called himself, "Roy the Baby Boy" because his brothers and sisters spoiled him from the youngest to the oldest. Leroy Taylor will be missed by all.

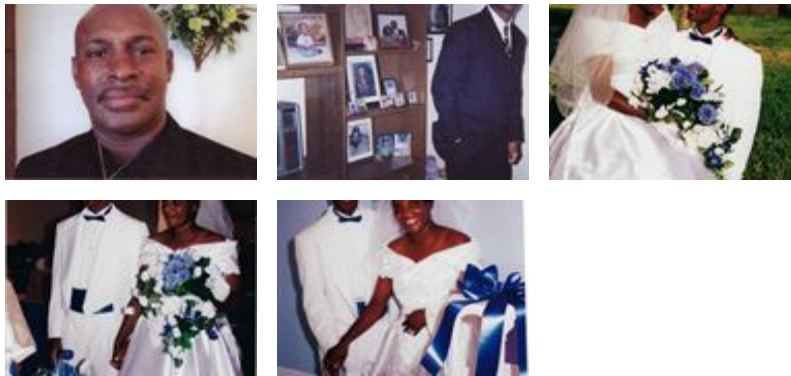

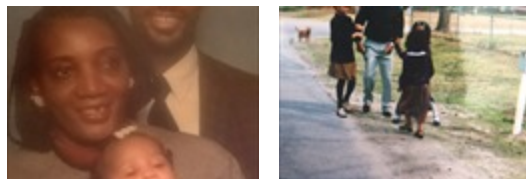
