Amos Jones, Jr. “Junie” was born on May 17, 1943, in Richmond, Virginia, to the late Amos and Lois Jones. He departed this life on Wednesday, October 21, 2020, at home with his family.

Amos attended Richmond Public Schools until he enlisted into the United States Army. He served his country in numerous capacities, enlisting in the United States Marine Corps Reserve and a member of the United States National Guard (102nd Engineer Battalion). He continued his service to faithfully serving his community as a New York Auxiliary Police Officer and the Pitt County Sheriff’s Citizen Police Patrol. He retired from the United States Postal Service after 27 years of employment in 1999.

Amos was preceded in death by his daughter, Keisha; brother, John Haywood Jones, Sr.; sister, Jeanette Jones Roane (James).

Amos leaves to carry on his legacy, his wife, Brenda; three children, Amos III (Sybil), Victor (Christine), Takia (Kyle); sister, Phyllis (Joe); twelve grandchildren; a host of nieces and nephews, other relatives and friends.

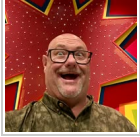
