He learned how to play the piano and organ under the instruction of Elder Brewington. He enjoyed listening to the preached word of God from Mother Smith. As a result, Pastor Amos developed a deep desire to teach the gospel to the world.

In 1971, he graduated from Franklin K. Lane High School in Brooklyn and became a part of the household of faith ministries within The Pentecostal Faith Church. He served as a chauffeur for the late founders and leaders. He also served as a youth camp counselor at Bethel Sunshine Camp in the Catskill Mountains of New York. He was ordained a Head Deacon and served faithfully under the leadership of Mother Bertha Henderson. Pastor Amos Wilson, Sr. held many jobs, but he worked at Hackney & Sons and United Insurance Company for many years before retiring. In, 2000 he became the Pastor of Mt. Olive PFC in Belhaven, NC. Throughout the course of his ministry, he led the reconstruction efforts of the church after it was burned down in a fire, he taught the word of God at various prisons within the community, he took chaplaincy course work through the chaplain program through Vidant Medical Center in Washington, NC, he also completed coursework in biblical studies, and he served as a councilman in Belhaven, NC in 2015.

Pastor Amos Wilson, Sr. was a dedicated servant of God who was faithful until the very end. Job well done, good and faithful servant.
