She will always be remembered as one of the toughest and fairest teachers I've ever known. She knew what each student was capable of and accepted no less. She never differentiated students by their race, who their parents were, any social status. She didn't care how difficult a student was she still continued to push and help them excel. I saw her with students who could try and average person and she kept right on. I always remembered her as being extremely tough and extremely fair. I've seen her take a student that was bigger and turn them over and tear their hind parts up and use that wooden paddle (that was feared by all) to bend those fingers all the way back and tear that hand up because you were doing less than what she knew you capable of. I also remember her putting together packets; soap, wash cloths for students that didn't have basic needs to have as rewards too. Although those who may never have met her may think she was extreme, she never once failed to lift a child and let them know they were capable of more. She was tough as they come and there should be more teachers like her that expected more and truly didn't judge one child better than another. The kids today wouldn't know what to do with a teacher like her. You can best believe they would intimidate her and they would respect her. Rest in peace Mrs. Horton!

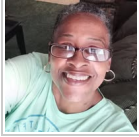
