



## Mr. Benjamin Earl Broadie

December 1, 1956 - April 23, 2014

Mr. Benjamin Earl Broadie entered eternal rest on Wednesday, April 23, 2014, at Chippenham-Johnston Willis (CJW) Medical Center, in Richmond, Virginia, after fighting a good fight of faith against his illness. He was 57 years old.
