Bertha Ann Daniels Mooring, daughter of the late Sister Martha “Mot” Daniels and the late Elder Lumas “Busta” Payton, was born on June 24, 1950 in Grimesland, NC. She departed this earthly home on Monday, December 22, 2025.

Bertha was a native of Pitt County and a graduate of G.R. Whitfield School class of 1968, Pitt Community College in Secretarial Science, United Christian College in Biblical Studies and attended numerous workshops and seminars.

Bertha confessed her faith at an early age and joined the White Oak Missionary Baptist Church. She served in the choir and as Associate Minister. She was ordained in Gospel Ministry in 2000 under the General Baptist Association. She later joined Saint Mary Missionary Baptist Church with her husband Jesse Ray Mooring.
