



## Mr. Brandt Hare

October 15, 1951 - September 27, 2022

Brandt Anthony Hare, the third of four children and only son of H. William and Constance Gambrell Hare, was born on October 15th 1951 (his father's birthday) and transitioned to glory on September 27, 2022.

Named after Willy Brandt, the former German Chancellor and 1971 Nobel Peace Prize recipient, Brandt was exceptionally gifted, and that intellect positively touched every aspect of his life and the lives of those around him. Born in Washington, DC, Brandt graduated from Eastern High School in 1969. While in school, he worked for Marion Barry's Youth Pride, Inc. after which he accepted an entry-level job at the Maryland National Capital Parks and Planning Commission. There, he quickly rose through the ranks to manage the Commission's facilities department until his retirement.

Debonaire and stylish, Brandt settled down and married the love of his life, Ramona Hart, in February 2020. Always a loving and devoted father, he cared deeply for Ramona and his sons and was a gracious provider for his family. His interests ranged from arts and sports (he was a win or lose Redskins/Commanders and Washington Bullets fan), to politics and social justice.

Brandt was a faithful member of Sycamore Hill Missionary Baptist Church in Greenville, NC. He attended church with his parents, oldest sister, and later his wife, Ramona. Brandt participated in the Male Choir and Usher Board.

Brandt was preceded in death by his dotting parents, William and Constance Hare; his oldest sister, Raleighe-Teal Franklin.

Brandt is survived by his wife, Ramona Brewington Hare; his sons, Brandt Anthony "Tony" Hare, Jr. (Janette "Pinkie"), Kenell Anton Hare; his grandsons, Brandon White and Anthony Ford; great grandson, Mars Ford; stepson, Chandler Everett; his sisters, Diane "Dee" Apetsi and Nasa "Penny" Miller-Edwards (Robert); a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and many other family and friends who will forever cherish his memory.
