She celebrated 65 years of marriage with her late husband, J.C Moore before his passing in 2015. Together they birthed and raised two boys, Van Cardell and Frankie Tyrone Moore. For thirty plus years, Carrie worked as an attendant for Central Laundry Services in New Jersey before retiring as a homemaker.
