



Ms. Catherine Pitt Jenkins

Catherine Pitt Jenkins (Cap) was born on October 14, 1921 to the late Lonnie and Ella Pitt in Fountain, NC. She departed this life peacefully at her home surrounded by her family on Wednesday, August 14, 2013.

Her early education started at Chance Parmele Training School in Parmele, NC. In 1964, she continued her education in English and Mathematics at the Robinson Union School in Winterville, NC.

In her earlier years she worked in tobacco and cotton. She also worked in private homes, churches, and business offices as a Domestic Housekeeper in the Pitt county area.

Catherine was known for her excellent ironing and cooking skills and will be highly remembered as a hard worker.

Catherine was employed with Pitt County Schools as a Teacher's Aide at Bethel Union High School for two (2) years. She later pursued a career at Black & Decker, in Tarboro NC, as a Parts Inspector in the Injection Molding Department where she retired after 20 years of service.

Catherine was the matriarch and the historian for her family; always encouraging them to PRAY, KNOW GOD FOR THEMSELVES and STAYING TOGETHER AS A FAMILY. She was also known for her wise counsel to anyone she met, and she never met a stranger.

She never met a stranger and was always eager to help others even if it meant assisting them with wise counsel to help them along their way.

Over the years Catherine learned much, especially while caring for her

parents and is leaving a great legacy for her children and grandchildren to live by. She rehearsed her wishes with her children years in advance of her demise in efforts to make their work easy. She stressed to them that she had her business with God and Man in order. She loved her family and friends dearly and never hesitated to speak the truth.

Catherine Pitt met and married the late Cottrell Stancil Jenkins on November 15, 1950. From that union was four (4) daughters: Betty, Margie, Camille and Susie. They were a very happy couple and they did many things together. Sis Catherine Pitt Jenkins accepted Christ and was baptized under the leadership of the late Reverend Nathan Brown at Wynn Chapel Missionary Baptist Church. Later she joined Riddick Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in 1946 on Christian Experience under the late Reverend Watson. She served as president of the Senior Choir and Secretary/Treasurer of the Women's Auxiliary where she was faithful and dedicated for a number of years, and supported all ministry functions. "She loved the hymn: "I will trust in the Lord." That was also her fathers' favorite hymn as well. Her favorite saying was "let the work I've done, speak for me". She loved her church and attended faithfully for as long as her health permitted. Sister Catherine P. Jenkins will be missed by her family, her church, and the community.

She was preceded in death by her three sisters; Mary Lee Spell, Nellie Gray Highsmith, and Bernice Hines.
