



## Mrs. Cora Powell

May 29, 1921 - July 8, 2015

On Wednesday, July 08, 2015 our beloved Cora Mae Moore Powell entered into eternal rest with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ at Martin General Hospital after a brief illness.

Cora was born on May 29, 1921 to the late Isaac and Lewelyn Moore in Beaufort County. She attended Beaufort County schools and after graduation she further her education at Elizabeth City State University, Elizabeth City, NC where she obtained her teacher's license, realizing she needed and wanted more education she attended Columbus University in New York. She had a deep compassion for kids and taught Pre-school for 40+ years at Beaufort County Elementary School and Snowden Elementary in Aurora, NC. She dedicated her life to her students, Family and Church.

Cora accepted Christ at an early age and was a faithful member of St. Matthews UAFWB Church in Bonnerton, NC; she also attended Moore's Chapel and Bethel Church along with others Church's in the community. She was very instrumental and held several positions at St. Matthews's church which included Church mother, Usher, and Trustee.

Cora was the president of North East B annual Ushers convention, member of the Bonnerton Busy Bee Club, and was on the committee for the Home renovations in Bonnerton, she was also very instrumental in establishing the

Bonnerton Community Club.

William and Cora Powell donated land for a Park to be built in Aurora, NC and later the Park was named The William and Cora Powell Park.

Cora met and married William Henry Powell, "THE LOVE OF HER LIFE", on August 4, 1945. To this union they had one son; Ronald Powell Sr. (preceded her in death)

Cora was also preceded in death by one brother, Eddie Moore; nieces, Belencia Moore and Earlyne Moore; nephew, Alvin Moore.
