Dennis Lane Taft, a beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, nephew, and cousin, passed away peacefully on December 9, 2024, leaving a profound legacy of love, service, and faith. He was 68 years old.

Dennis was born on September 12, 1956, in Pitt County to Leon Gilbert Sr. and Elizabeth Jane “Janie” Taft. He graduated from J. H. Rose High School in 1976, where he laid the foundation for a life committed to hard work, kindness, and service to others.

Over the years, Dennis demonstrated unwavering dedication and care in a wide range of roles. He started with furniture delivery and upholstery at Thomas Willis Furniture and Interior Decorators, where he quickly earned a reputation for his reliability and attention to detail. He then transitioned to the medical field, serving as a Surgical Tech at Greenville Surgical Center, where his commitment to patient care was evident. He went on to serve as the founding pastor of the Church of God of Purpose, where he touched countless lives with his unwavering faith, dedication, and love. Dennis was more than a pastor—he was a servant leader who spent his life spreading the gospel and lifting up those around him.

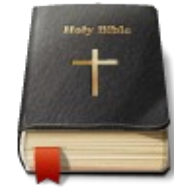
