Dorothy Flora Wynn, the second of seven children of Wilbur and Ester Jones Wynn was born in Baltimore, Maryland on September 26, 1933, and departed this life on Sunday, August 6, 2023 in Winston Salem, NC.

Dorothy lived her life in stages, after leaving Baltimore, Maryland, her formative years continued when she moved to North Carolina with her older sister Dolores and her younger brother, Wilbur Jr. (AKA June), to live on the farm of grandparents, Owen and Mattie Bryant Jones. While living in Oak City, she joined St. Mark Baptist Church, where going to church was a must in her home. Dorothy attended the North Carolina public schools, graduated from W.C. Chance High School in Parmele, NC., in 1952. After graduation, she attended Winston Salem Teacher's College and received a bachelor's degree in early childhood education. Dorothy worked for the Board of Education for over 25 years as a teacher at P.S 275 in Brooklyn, NY, where she taught 4th grade. All her students "Loved Ms. Wynn".

Dorothy relocated to Brooklyn, NY and obtained employment with Bonds department store. Going to church and having God in her life was instilled in her at an early age. Seeking a church home, she found Bethany Baptist Church, under the pastorate of the late Rev. Thomas Jefferson Goodall. Dorothy remained a faithful member of the North Carolina Ministry, the Floral club, and taught Sunday School in her early years.

"Dot" as everyone called her, retired in 1991 and joined the prestigious Theta chapter of Phi Delta Kappa Sorority, Inc. Her most beloved teacher's

organization.
