day.

Eula spent many beautiful years working with the Biggs Funeral Home family, developing a profound relationship that felt like family. Her happiest weekends were spent in their company—drinking coffee, tidying up, and sharing stories about life’s journey. She held a special place in her heart for her true and lasting friendship with the late Ms. Julia Biggs and the entire Biggs family. A phenomenal cook, Eula expressed her love through food. She cooked full, delicious meals every single Sunday and lived for family gatherings during Christmas, Thanksgiving, and Homecoming. She was an avid shopper who loved hunting for sales, frequently spotting the best deals at the Williamston Piggly Wiggly or catching the turkey sales at Food Lion. Above all, she loved laughter, cherished her family, and her grandchildren were truly her world. Above all, Eula was a devoted mother who poured love into her family.
