The late Evateen “Teen” Barnes Jenkins was born on August 20, 1932 to the late Lonnie and Lillian Barnes in Pitt County, North Carolina and entered into eternal rest on September 10, 2016.

In 1948, “Teen” met and married her husband of 55 years, the late William “Bud” Jenkins on November 8th that same year. To that union seven children were born who lovingly called her “Ma Ma”; however, her extended family reached far into the communities where she was also affectionately referred to by many other children as “Ma Ma”. Even to this day she is still referred to as “Ma Ma.”

“Teen’s” formal education included graduation from Bethel High School, Bethel, North Carolina and Beaufort Community College, Washington, North Carolina as a Licensed Practical Nurse. She immediately secured a Registered Nurse license upon completion of the nursing board exam and served in this capacity for thirty-two years.

“Teen” was a devoted Christian who served diligently in church and

community activities, which included ushering, teaching, serving the youth, and singing in the choir as well as other venues. Community activities included membership in the Bethel Community Florist Club and the Bethel Light Court #622. She was also noted for participating in any capacity with the various community projects.
