George Washington Joyner was born August 12, 1919 in the Bell Town community of Williamston, NC to the late Lonius Joyner and the late Nancy Bell Joyner. He was the youngest of five children.

George attended school in Martin County, NC. After graduation he enlisted to serve in the United States Air Force during World War II and remained active until he was honorably discharged with a rank of Staff Sargent. He moved to New Jersey where he worked in the school system, owned and operated a Transport vehicle for many years.

George was a long-standing member of Sharon Baptist Church in New Brunswick, NJ, where he served on the Deacon Board, until he relocated back to Williamston, NC. He then joined Cedar Hill Missionary Baptist Church and was a member of the Deacon Board. He was dedicated to his community and was willing to serve with a never tiring attitude.

George was preceded in death by four sisters; Novella Bonds, Lula Joyner, Sarah Huff, and Ora Mitchell; two nephews, Frederick Levone Joyner and William Harold Joyner.
