Gertha Mae W. Crumpler was born on September 19, 1950, in Wilson, North Carolina to Jessie Bell Williams and William Henry Vick. She was raised by her mother and James “Buddy” Williams who was a loving father to Gertha. She went home to be with the Lord on December 3, 2023.

Gertha graduated from Charles H. Darden High School in Wilson, NC and attended Livingstone College in Salisbury, NC before beginning her career at North Carolina National Bank in Greenville, NC, which later became known as Bank of America. She enjoyed a 42-year career with Bank of America where she worked in Greenville, Wilmington, and Charlotte, NC before retiring in 2020. Throughout her career, Gertha discovered many incredible blessings, both professionally and personally, as she “was able to meet, assist, and work with some absolutely amazing co-workers, customers, and clients for many years.” Her exceptional service and care are still talked about by many who experienced what amounted to Gertha living out her purpose and calling.

A long-time resident of Greenville, NC, she was a dedicated member of Cornerstone Missionary Baptist Church where she was a member of the Young Adult Choir, the Board of Evangelism, and Sunday School. Wherever she served, the testimony about Gertha was always the same: She embodied the love of Jesus in her words and actions. No one left her presence without feeling loved and valued.

After relocating to Charlotte from Wilmington, NC, Gertha became a member of Friendship Missionary Baptist Church. She was a faithful and cherished member of the Empowered Disciples Sunday School Class and never failed to reach out to fellow class members with cards, texts, and encouraging phone calls.

Gertha's faith was her firm foundation, and she nurtured her family with the same love and care. A proud mother of three sons, Gertha was ardently supportive. She attended sporting events and musical performances faithfully and joyfully. She was an adored grandmother of six grandchildren, each of whom she cherished deeply. In addition, her warm and caring nature earned her the name "Mama Crump" from her sons' classmates, teammates, and from her colleagues across the state.

Gertha was a bold prayer warrior, and her prayers and wise counsel uplifted family, friends, and even acquaintances. She never met a stranger! Her life was a tapestry woven with threads of gratitude and grace. Without exaggeration, it is impossible to know the countless lives Gertha touched.

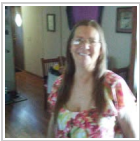
