Glenda Jean Bryant, the daughter of the late William Sherman Dawes and Cora Reddick Dawes, was born July 29, 1963, in Robersonville, North Carolina. Glenda's Christian life began at an early age, at Bible Way Apostolic Church, Williamston, NC, under the leadership of the late David A. Carter. Glenda was baptized in Jesus Name and received the gift of the Holy Ghost with evidence of speaking in tongues.

While at Bible Way, Glenda unveiled her singing talent, for which she enjoyed sharing to the Saints, and, as a member of the Youth Choir, and, as part of a singing group, called Joy. For nearly 22 years, Glenda was an active member of the Refuge One Way Holiness Church. Since joining Refuge One Way, she was an aspiring missionary, Sunday school teacher, and President of the Usher Board.

Glenda was a 1981 graduate of Roanoke High School, Robersonville, NC. She attended Fayetteville State University and Pitt Community College, where she graduated with a degree in Network Administration. Additionally, Glenda worked for Proctor and Gamble Company for 10 years. After leaving Proctor and Gamble, she became the owner and CEO of Ultimate Home Health Care and Transportation for more than 17 years, until her health began to decline. Glenda's Christian life, contribution, work, and legacy are remembered by

many, including a host of nieces, nephews, other families, and friends.
