Gloria attended E.J. Hayes School in Williamston, NC and graduated in 1961, going on to further her education at Martin Community College in Williamston, NC, she graduated with an Associate Degree in Applied Sciences in Cosmetology. Gloria attended Elizabeth City State University in Elizabeth City, NC.

On February 9, 1985 she was joined in holy matrimony to Clifton Earl Davis, Jr.

Gloria is remembered as a community champion as she proudly served and advocated for local, state and national legislation officials. She served on Martin Community Action Board and at the time of her passing was an active Town Commissioner for the town of Williamston. Social Services and 13 years at North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles, where she later retired in 2011.
