James Lamarr Cooper "Jim" 79, was born on August 13, 1943, in Miami Beach, Florida, and was called to the Spirit World by the Creator on October, 16, 2022. He was the son of the late Ruth E. Mayo and Charles E. Mayo.

Jim served in the U.S. Air Force and moved to Pitt County from Florida. He retired from St. Peter School Maintenance Department in Greenville, NC. Jim enjoyed teaching other human beings about Native American Culture and creating Native American arts and crafts in his woodshop. Jim also was an Native American Flute Player and released several CDs featuring his music. Jim inspired others to play and make their own flutes and he took great pride in sharing his gift. . Jim was a member of Eastern Bull Drum and Singers and traveled the powwow circuit throughout the country. He was an active member of Epsilon Chi Nu Fraternity, the first Native American Fraternity in the United States.

He is preceded in death by his Native brother, Mr.. Connie Glast.

James is survived by his wife, Linda L. Cooper; daughter, Kristina L. Cooper; grandson, Quintin H. Cooper; and Native brother, Joey Crutchfield, as well as extended family, friends from the powwow community, former students and staff of St. Peter School. and many others.
