While

there he worked in the maintenance department, handled dealership transfer

as

requested and traveled for the company as needed. There was no place that

he

could not locate. The distance was no problem.

After retirement he began gardening and raised a variety of vegetables.

Planting

collards was his specialty. People locally and travelers stopped in to purchase

his

vegetables. Jasper set up a self-service system that worked very well. He was

known

as the "Collard Man."

Jasper's family was his top priority. They went on educational and sightseeing

trips. The sons were taught good work ethics, such as making sensible

purchases,

how to deal with banking and to never go beyond your means. Father and son

talks

were done as often as needed. Jasper had a lot of wisdom. Many young

people who

got to know him would stop in just to talk. He got joy out of watching the news

and discussing the location of where it happened.

Jasper enjoyed his grandchildren and shared many stories with them. They

loved

riding on the tractor and watching him transplant and hand set certain

vegetables.

Jasper is survived by his wife, Lula H. Council; sons, Jasper Council, Jr.,
