December 22, 1914 - March 5, 2015

Julia Wallace Congleton departed from her earthly body and ascended to be with the Lord early in the morning of March 5, 2015.

She attended the Martin County schools. Many years later, she received her certification in nutrition from East Carolina University which led to a second career as a nutritionist and cafeteria manager with the Martin Community Action Headstart Program.

A native of Everetts, North Carolina, Mother Congleton spent much of her adult life in Robersonville, NC. At an early age, she married Samuel Congleton who preceded her in death. Through this union, there were eight children, two of whom, James Samuel Congleton and Donna Watts Congleton, also preceded her in death.

For eighty-nine years, she was a member of the Lily of the Valley Missionary Church. She sang in the choir and graced the Mother Auxiliary with her quiet spirit for many of those years.

With her positive attitude and ever-present warm and friendly smile, she continued to amaze everyone even during her last days. Wishing never to be idle, she enjoyed spending time with her family, cooking, reading the Bible and her Sunday School commentary, watching religious programs on television,

and being a fashion diva.
