Kelvin Rodgers was born July 11, 1953 to the late Leroy and Ida Jane Rodgers. He was reared in a home with strong religious beliefs and at an early age he became a member of Cedar Hill Missionary Baptist Church. Kelvin was an active member until he was involved in a tragic car accident that left him totally disabled.

Kelvin attended Martin County schools and was employed with Rodgers Construction as a carpenter until his injuries. A hard worker, Kelvin was a dedicated employee and enjoyed being part of a company that was owned and operated by his brother "Skeet".

Kelvin had a "humble" and unwavering spirit and personality. For 4 years he endured a life of having to be totally dependent on others, but he never complained. His eyes would light up when he saw "Brenda Boston" walk into the room; everyone else was secondary to her. He enjoyed laughing and calling her by her whole name. Kelvin's care was top priority for his sisters, nieces, nephews, and his devoted brother, Milford.

Kelvin Rodgers transitioned from this earthly home to heaven on January 21, 2018. In addition to his parents, one brother, James Earl "Skeet" Rodgers preceded him in death.

To honor his memory he leaves four sisters, Jovita Rodgers Williams (McKinley) of the home, Brenda Rodgers Boston, Theresa Rodgers Sharpe, and Greta Rodgers Savage (Johnny) all of Williamston, NC; three brothers, Milford Rodgers (Deborah) of Washington NC, Jeffrey Rodgers and Michael Rodgers (Brenda) both of Williamston NC; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and family friends.
