Laura Eula Brown Stanback was born on March 23, 1938 in Williamston, NC to the late William C. Brown and the late Laura W. Brown. She was the sixth child of eleven children. Laura was given the nickname “Sister” and she loved to be called “Aunt Laura”. On Thursday July 9, 2015, she departed this life at Gilchrist Howard County Hospice of Columbia, Maryland.
