Lewis Edward Carter II was born on October 23, 1962 to the union of Lewis Carter and Susie Kelly Carter. He departed this life on September 9, 2024. Lewis was preceded in death by his father, Lewis Carter and his older brother Chester Carter.

Lewis attended Edenton-Chowan County Schools and was a proud graduate of the class of 1980 from John A. Holmes High School. He participated in many extracurricular activities but playing football was his love. Following graduation, he attended North Carolina Agricultural & Technical State University, where he studied Sociology, before transferring to Elizabeth City State University where he completed his Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice in 1986.

With his criminal justice degree, Lewis followed in his father's footsteps and in 1986 began working for the North Carolina Department of Corrections. He enjoyed his time with Pasquotank Correctional Institute and received many promotional opportunities. He was initially hired as an officer and soon rose to Program Assistant, Program Supervisor and lastly, Unit Manager. After leaving the Department of Corrections in 2003, Lewis worked at Regulator Marine, Inc. for a few years before discovering a new passion working with the youth at the Northeastern Workforce Development Board until his retirement in 2018.

Lewis loved watching sports, especially football, and more importantly the Pittsburgh Steelers. He also enjoyed listening to music and was a huge fan of Earth, Wind, and Fire. His sons remember him singing 90's R&B hits and blasting Cameo's "Candy". Lewis was a natural people person, and he had quite a few friends and admirers that he would often entertain with stories and laughs over a good drink.

Lewis is survived by his mother, Susie of Edenton, NC; his two sons, Forgét Carter of Greensboro, NC and Travarie Carter of Raleigh, NC; a host of cousins, friends, and loved ones.
