He sent an angel with an invitation on Sunday morning, July 28, 2013, to “come unto Him and rest.” Mother Ebron was born in Pitt County, December 28, 1921, to the late Louis and Laura Daniel Short. She was next to the youngest of her sixteen siblings, all who preceded her in death. Cousin Louise was in the first graduating class of C. M. Eppes High School, the class of May 28, 1942. On August 28, 1943, she married her first love, the late James Lee Ebron Sr. They were the proud parents of seven children. Two children, James Jr and Cedric preceded them in death. Aunt Louise was a retiree of Imperial Tobacco company. She was baptized September 28, 1935 and became a lifelong member of St. Peter Missionary Baptist Church.
