Mae received an associates degree in Secretary Science, a B.S in Human Resource from St. Joseph College, a B.A in Religious Education from Ephraim Moore University and Theological Seminary, and a M.S in Organizational Behavior from Polytechnic University in New York.

Mae received a certificate in Pastoral Care and worked as a pastoral care volunteer at the Brooklyn Hospital. She received a certificate in alcoholism from Kings County in Brooklyn, New York.

She attended the Open Door Church of God in Christ located in Brooklyn, New York and became an evangelist. Mae did nursing home ministry, prison ministry, shelters, ministries for the homeless. She was employed by Pfizer for thirty-three and then retired.

Mae moved to Greenville, NC from Brooklyn, NY. She then became a member of Wells Chapel Church of God in Christ. Mae was also featured in the eighteenth edition of the Who's Who of American Women in 1993-1994. She loved music and played several instruments including the piano, guitar, and saxophone.

Mae is preceded in death by her parents, Dave Moore and Marie Mallory, son, Valentino Bell; brother, William Bartley, and sister, Joanne Harrington
