Major was born in Martin County, North Carolina on December 27, 1942. He attended Bethel Union High School in Bethel, North Carolina. A conscientious worker, Major worked with his father on the farm until he married and relocated.

Major married the love of his life and high school sweet heart Carrie L. Andrews on December 19, 1964 and they relocated to New Haven, Connecticut in 1965. He was a member of Mt Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in New Haven, CT and actively served as a member of the male chorus.

Although Major had many different jobs, he is best known for his work as a bus driver. He worked for Constitution Coach, Inc. Major loved the road and could proudly tell you how to find your way on any highway anywhere in the continental United States as well as the cheapest gas locations. He enjoyed singing and traveling. A caring and loving man, Major always presented himself in a cool, calm and collective manner; often greeting family and friends with a hug and kiss.
