Malik was the the 2nd grandchild of Darnell and Gladys Ore of Williamston, NC. His granddad Thomas Hill of Baltimore, MD and would later move to Williamston, NC to be closer to the family.

Grandmother Isolean Hill Brown transitioned before the birth of Malik. As a child he enjoyed a close relationship with his aunts and uncles (Darryl, Anthony, Ricky, Rodney, Angela, Jenelle). His aunt Devie transitioned prior to his birth. Malik was the very proud uncle of Khalis and Majik Ore. He would move to Greenville, NC with his family and graduate from DH Conley High School.

Malik was the inspiration for his family to open their own childcare business. His famous phrase at the center “I just want to go give my mom a hug and kiss” which was a sure way of getting him out of class. Growing up he enjoyed swimming, basketball, baseball, football, and music. He attended numerous sports camps at universities all over. Being a natural leader, he created a band with a few friends. They sung everything from the Temptations to Elvis. At 11 years old he started his own lawn care business. His friend wanted to be a partner, but Malik informed him that he was providing all equipment and transportation, so his friend had to be an employee. He would later become the manager for his cousin, Quin Hill, aspiring music/rapping career. You couldn’t find a more loyal and dedicated person to family and friends. His motto was “Loyalty Over Royalty.” He would once again prove this when he joined his big brother in the family dump trucking business. Malik often expressed his sincere gratitude for his brother, Chuck, paving the way for him to get into the business. They worked side by side which only strengthen the unbreakable bond they already shared.

Securing his passport at 9 years old to travel in and out of the country with his family, developed a love for traveling and new experiences for him. He continued his travels including taking some trips by himself. Some of his favorite places included Florida, New York (Time Square), Jamaica, California, Hawaii and Puerto Rico. He enjoyed attending professional sporting events, countless concerts and events.

Malik definitely believed in enjoying his life. With strong family roots already in place from day one he was able to inspire and create strong bonds with others. 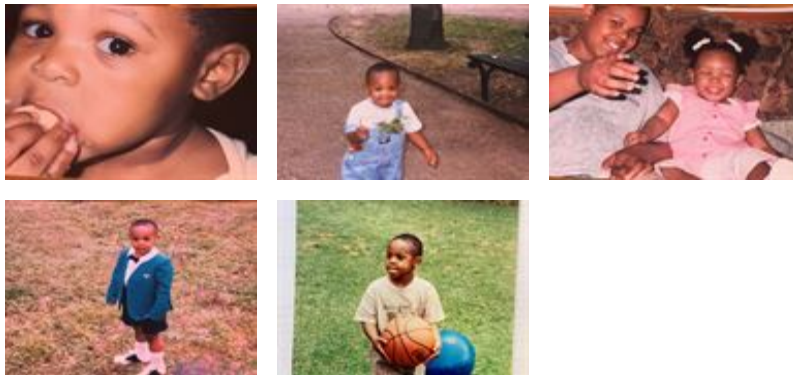

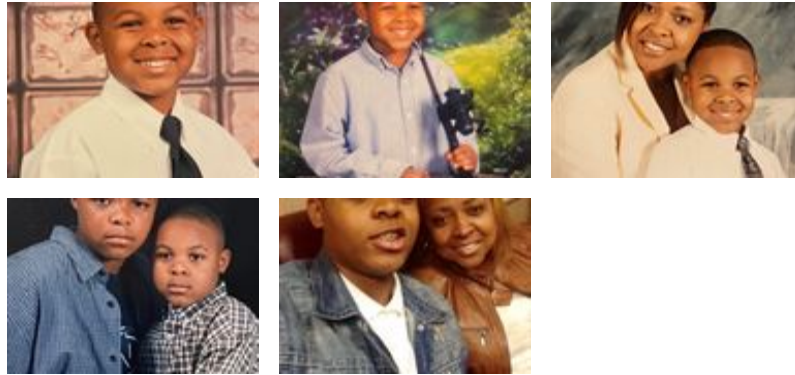
