Marian Norcott Langley was born on July 19, 1931 in Greenville, NC to the late Marion and the late Blanche Norcott. On June 23, 2018, after a short illness, Marian departed this life to be with our Lord and Savior.

Marian's Christian walk began at Sycamore Hill Missionary Baptist Church where she joined at an early age. A graduate of C.M. Eppes High School, Marian received her Bachelor's Degree from Winston Salem Teachers' College, now Winston Salem State University, and her Master's from New York University. She also studied at William & Mary College and Old Dominion University.

In 1956 Marian married her high school sweetheart, the late William L. Langley, Sr. They relocated to Newport News, VA. and God blessed their union with one son, William L. Langley, Jr.

A lover of children and a passionate educator, Marian taught elementary school at Dunbar-Erwin in Newport News, VA. Marian taught for thirty six years, and thirty four of those thirty six years, she taught in the very same classroom, until retirement. Even after her retirement, Marian continued to invest in the education of future generations through her work with the children's choir at First Church (Baptist) of Newport News and the mentoring program at Huntington Middle School.

Marian loved her community and leveraged every opportunity to give back through service. A longtime member of First Church (Baptist) of Newport News, as a member, Marian was the Chairman of the Hospitality Committee, assisted with the Youth Department, and was a member of the Senior Choir. She was a member of the Newport News Alumni Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. Marian was also a founding member of the Newport News Chapter of Las Amigas, Inc., a member of the Dochiki Wives Auxiliary of Newport News, and a past President of the Hampton Roads Chapter of C.M. Eppes Alumni Association.

Marian is survived by her son, William L. Langley, Jr. of Clinton, MD; two brothers, Lonnie A. Norcott of Greenville, NC and George Breon (Flora) of Tampa FL; three grandchildren, Adrian L. 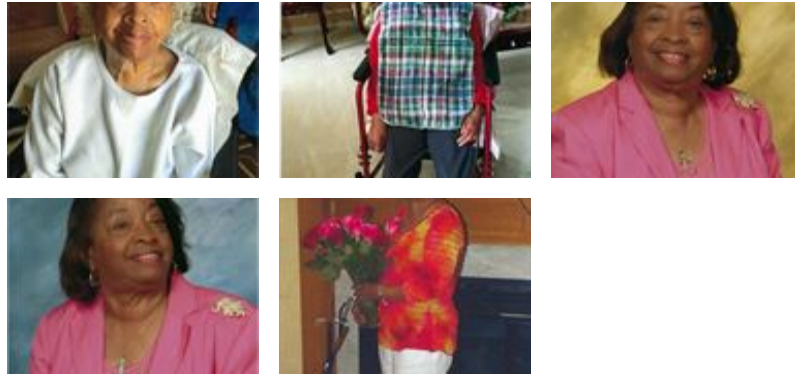
