He was also a member of Ware Creek Community Center Club. Nathan was a farmer, owned a logging business and once operated a country store in which people came miles to patronize. He also raised hogs and grew a garden large enough for the community. Nathan served in World War II and received the Asiatic Pacific Theater Medal and the World War II Victory Medal. You would often see him with his Army cap on when going out to the doctor and other places. Nathan loved to travel! During the summer, he would travel with his daughters and sons-in-law to Florida, Maryland, Ohio and California. He would also go on the class trips with his grandchildren. Nathan's passion was reading and he loved to read the encyclopedia. He would do the word scramble in the newspaper each day and work in his puzzle books. 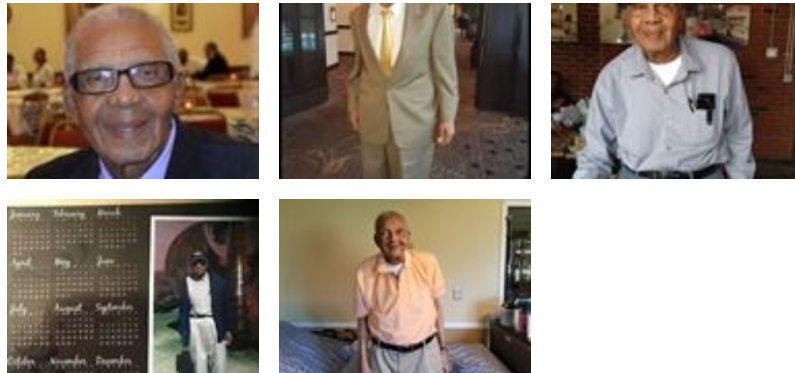
