Nicole attended Frederick High School and graduated in the year 2000. During her senior year, she also attended the Career and Tech Center in Frederick where she took preliminary classes preparing for Medical

In her younger years, she worked at Citizens Nursing Home in Frederick and Frederick Memorial Hospital. Nicole attended Kaplan University where she obtained her Associates Degree from their Medical Assistant Program. Nicole was employed at various Medical Facilities in Frederick County and Montgomery County, Maryland.

Nicole was a very friendly and jovial person with a great sense of humor. During our times together as a family, she would always make us laugh. Nicole, and her only sibling Jermaine, were very close and loved each other dearly. After her parents retired and moved to North Carolina, her brother was diagnosed with MS.
