Apostle Paul A. Thomas was born and reared in Brooklyn, NY. He accepted Christ at an early age and began to pursue a life of Christian service. He is a graduate of the Ecumenical Institute of Religion in Chicago, IL where he received his Bachelor's degree in Sociological Religious Studies. He furthered his education at Rutgers University and Philadelphia College of the Bible where he received his Master's degree in Social Theology.

Apostle Thomas received an Honorary Doctorate of Divinity degree from Vision Christian University in Pomona, California and Central Christian University in Blytheville, Arkansas. In 2002, Apostle Thomas received his PhD from Central Christian University. On June 28, 2014, Apostle Thomas received an Honorary Doctor of Sacred Letters from Covenant Theological Seminary in Greenville, North Carolina.

His ministry has led him as a much sought after evangelist where he has traveled extensively in the United States and internationally. His Wife Katie A. Thomas traveled with him.

In 1976, he founded Victory Christian Assembly where he is the Senior Pastor. Additionally, he is the founder of The United Christian Alliance, Inc.: A fellowship of pastors throughout the United States who are repairers of the breach as they unite as a prophetic, apostolic team to build the universal Kingdom of God.

Apostle Thomas serves as a spiritual father to many sons and daughters

throughout the nation and abroad, He has authored several books, which have been a blessing to millions. His latest books are "Supporting the Leaders Around You", "Potiphar's House", "The Kingdom Shift", "Onward Prophecy", "Managing Your Life" and "The Bump in the Road" which is predestined to be a best seller.

In December 2007, Bishop Thomas was elevated to office of Apostle. This apostolic anointing has enabled him to move into many areas expanding the Kingdom of God with influence, wisdom and authority. Apostle Thomas married Miss Katie Alexander in November 1971. Apostle Thomas was preceded in death by his father, Samuel Arnold Thomas, Mother, Agnes Fritz-Hugh Thomas and daughter, Eileen Thomas.
