October 15, 1928 - March 15, 2013

Mr. Plum Rogers was born October 15, 1928 in Martin County. He was the son of the late James Bennette and Della Latham Rodgers. He departed this life on Friday, March 15, 2013.

Plum joined Cedar Hill Baptist Church at an early age and later joined Chapel Hill Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. T. R. Vines where he served as Chairman Deacon until death. He was Superintendent of the Sunday School, member of the Gospel Choir, the Heavenly Voices Males Chorus and Chairman of the United Fellowship Committee.

He was 33° Mason Grand Inspector General, member and past Worshipful Master of Carnation Lodge 151, PHA of Williamston, NC. He was also Worthy Patron and member of Eureka Chapter 66, District 9 Order of the Eastern Star, member of NAACP and past member of North Carolina Sheriff Association.

Plum was a retired Deputy Sheriff for Martin County. After retirement, he was the owner of Rogers' Taxi and his slogan was "Don't Thumb, Call Plum."

On July 31, 1948, he was joined in Holy Matrimony to Hattie Rhodes and was blessed with six children. One son, Jimmy Rogers, preceded him in death.

Two grandchildren, five sisters and three brothers preceded him in death Plum leaves to cherish his memories, his wife of 64 years, Hattie
