



## Mrs Priscilla Floyd Moore Tyson

June 10, 1921 - October 5, 2011

Priscilla Floyd Moore Tyson, 90, of Greenville, North Carolina went home to glory on Wednesday, October 5, 2011. Priscilla was born to the late John Floyd and Olivia Ann Copper Floyd of Pitt County, North Carolina, the fifth of thirteen children. She grew up in Simpson and later moved to Greenville.

As a young girl, she joined Sweet Hope Free Will Baptist Church of Grimesland. Priscilla's favorite song was Precious Lord Take My Hand. Her favorite scripture was Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, A Time for Everything.

Priscilla was a devout Christian, served as a mother of the church, and always reserved her Sundays for service to the Lord. She was actively involved in many activities of the church until her health failed. She served as chairperson of the Kitchen Committee, member of the Home Mission, and dedicated former president and servant of the Willing Workers Club until it disbanded. She also sang as an exceptional alto in the Sweet Hope Senior Choir for numerous years and for forty years, was a member of the Ladies Delight OES Chapter #10.

She married Rubin Moore early in life, and later in 1969, Priscilla married Reverend Jasper Lee Tyson of Greenville. They continued to live in happy matrimony until his death in 1998. Two sons preceded her in death, Charles Ray and James Calvin.
