Rexson Solomon Sandy known by his family as “Solo” was born to the union of William and Mariam Sandy in West Africa. Rexson departed this life on March 25, 2018.

Rexson received his high school education in Sierra Leone, West Africa and later migrated to Liberia, where he met Patricia Kamah. They both studied the Bible with Jehovah’s Witnesses and dedicated their lives serving as one of Jehovah’s servant in August of 1977. Rexson and Patricia were married on December 17, 1977.

Rexson did extensive corresponding studies as a bookkeeper and worked for the Investment Bank of Liberia. He wanted to pursue higher education, so he traveled to The United States of America in 1979. He was joined by his wife in 1980. Rexson graduated with his master degree in accountant from the University of Jackson State, Mississippi. The union of Rexson and Patricia was blessed with three sons. After seven years of life in Mississippi, the family moved to North Carolina. They resided in Raleigh for ten years. During this time Rexson studied for his PHD and briefly worked for Shaw University teaching accountant. In 1999 Rexson and his family built a home in Greenville, NC and they resided there until 2008 when Rexson decided to return to Africa. Rexson became ill in Africa and returned to America in November 2017 to seek medical care. His illness was so advanced that he didn’t recover.

Rexson Solomon Sandy left behind the mother of his children, Patricia Sandy; three sons, Alex, Azriel, Azzan; two daughters-in-law, Aubrie and Jasmine; four grandchildren, Jalen, Serenity, London and Camryn; a host of other relatives and friends.
