Rev. Robert Lee Hudson, Sr was born in Washington County, NC on November 20, 1942 to Thomas Moore, Sr and Emma Andrews Hudson. On August 22, 1963 he was united in Holy Matrimony to Doris Ann Lee. He departed this life on Saturday, December 24, 2011.

Robert joined the United States Army, where he received an honorable discharge.

Robert received his formal education from Martin County Schools, NC. He eventually continued his learning at the Atlantic Community College and Ricahrd Stockton College, both of New Jersey. Robert also obtained his Biblical education by attending the Garden State Bible School in New Jersey. Robert was a longtime member of Chapel Hill Missionary Baptist Church of Robersonville, NC where he served as an Associate Minister. When he resided in New Jersey, Robert was affiliated with Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church of Pleasantville, NJ, where he was ordained as a Deacon, Faith Baptist Chruch of Ocean City, NJ where he accepted his calling into the Ministry. He then served at First Baptist Church of Woodbine, NJ as an Associate Minister. Robert retired as a Sherriff's Officer for Atlantic County, NJ after many years of service. He later would work various positions in New Jersey and North Carolina, including being a Gospel Radio Personality (DJ).
