Rosa Patricia Lee Mair, 76, of Greenville passed away on January 20, 2024, after a brief illness.

She was born on June 20, 1947, in Philadelphia, PA; the first of Hazel and Herbert Lee's four daughters.

After graduating from WH Taft High School (Bronx, NY) and Lehman College (Bronx, NY), Patricia began her career in education in New York City in the early 1970s. In 1978, she began a 28 and a half year stint with Pitt County Schools (mostly at South Greenville Elementary); retiring in 2007.
