Sandra attended school in Washington, North Carolina; graduated from Washington high School. She went to Beaufort Community College where she received her Associate Degree in Business Administration and Accounting.

She later gained employment at Beaufort County Environmental Health as an Administrator until she was called home.

Ms. Albritton accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Lord and Savior at a very young age. She was a life time member of Davenport Temple Church of God in Christ, under the leadership of Bishop Leroy Jackson Woolard. She served as Vice President of the Ushers' Board, Young People Willing Workers (YPWW) Teacher, Sunday School Teacher, Vice President, Senior Citizens' Ministry, a member of the Security Team. She was the Coordinator of Annual Family Week of Service at Davenport Temple Church of God in Christ. She was in charge of the church's marquee and selected the weekly sayings.

She was also known as the "Candy Lady". And practically every Sunday after church, she would distribute candy to the children. In her community, she

served as the Secretary of the NAACP and Secretary for the Smallwood Family Reunion.

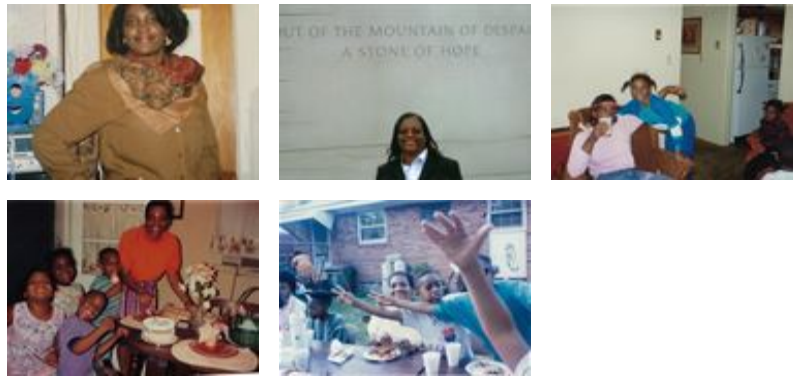
