After graduating, she attended North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University, Greensboro, North Carolina where she received a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education. She later enlisted into the Army Reserves, where she served for four years. Her professional career began in Robeson County Public Schools in Lumberton, North Carolina and later relocated to Pitt County Schools where she taught for 30 years until her retirement. She was a passionate educator who created a classroom full of pride and recognition. Her influence impacted the lives of so many students, parents, and colleagues as she was most known for making learning fun.
