Waldo became a member of St. Mary Church of Christ (Disciples of Christ) at an early age.

Waldo was a graduate of Mattamuskeet High School Class of 1987. For several years he was employed at Mattamuskeet Seafood Company. Later he relocated to Raleigh, NC where he was employed for fifteen years as a cashier at Sears. While there he united with Elevation Baptist Church with his brother. There he met and married Denise Rogers and their union spanned fourteen years. They were blessed to legally adopt two brothers Kenneth and Raheim Murray and reared them as their own.
