



Mr. Willie R. Matthewson, Jr.

September 22, 1940 - April 8, 2019

On April 8, 2019, Willie Raphael Matthewson, Jr. left family and friends to take residence in a new home. Affectionately known, as “Ray” and “Tug”, he was born to the late Willie Raphael Matthewson, Sr. and Cordelia Watkins Matthewson in Tarboro, NC on September 22, 1940.

Ray was educated in the public schools of Tarboro, NC and graduated from Patilla High School. After enrolling in Winston-Salem Teachers College (now Winston-Salem State University) in 1962, he enlisted in the US Army in 1965 and served two years in the Korean Conflict as a military police. Following his Honorable discharge, he returned to Winston-Salem State University and received a B.S. degree in Elementary Education in 1971. After graduation, he pursued further education and certifications from Wilkes Community College, Wayne Community College and an automotive dealership as a certified Volkswagen mechanic.

Ray’s employment included working at RJ Reynolds Tobacco in Winston-Salem, Flow Motors as a certified mechanic, an elementary school as a teacher and group homes as a counselor. Most recently, he was self-employed as an entrepreneur. As an avid explorer and lifelong learner, he was a brilliant character, having a strong passion for people, dogs, cars and reading.

Ray was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Ava "Yadie" Matthewson Bryant.

Ray is survived by three daughters, Minnie Ruth Bullock (David) of Tarboro, NC, Kimberly Broadnax (Lewis) and J. Denise Matthewson (Lamont Witherspoon) all of Durham, NC; sons, Darryl Earl Evans of Tustin, CA and Willie R. Matthewson, III of Bellevue, WA; brothers, H. 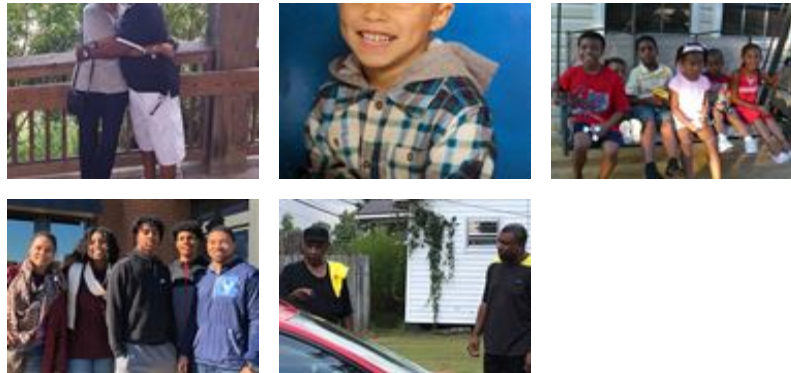

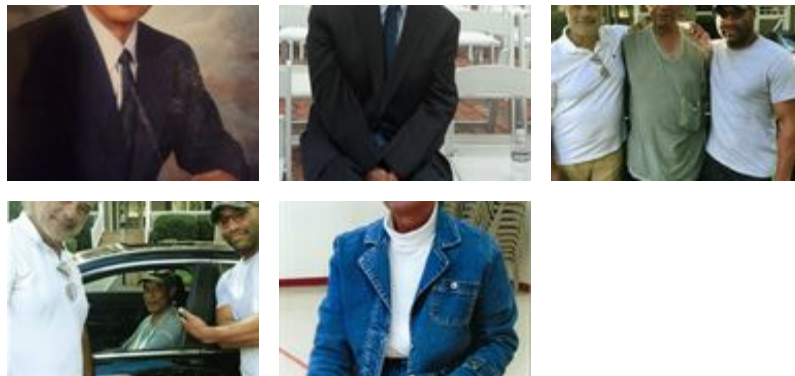
