Pastor Hamilton became the pastor of St. Monica Missionary Baptist Church of Grimesland, NC in 2018 and remained until his death. He loved preaching and ministering to his members. Under his ministry there he established a Food Outreach Ministry and a supporter of the Men’s Fellowship Choirs. These choirs included six different churches and denominations coming together every other month to sing the Gospel. Pastor Hamilton also pastored at St. John Missionary Baptist Church, Aurora, NC for fifteen (15) years.

He was a member of the New Bern Eastern Missionary Baptist Association Executive Board as well as holding the office of Vice President of the Beaufort/Pitt Union.

Pastor Hamilton retired from Nutrient Phosphate in Aurora, NC as an A Operator after 44 years of service. His was a Pittsburgh Steeler fan and loved traveling.
