Zelma received her early education in the Pitt County School System of Greenville. After graduating from high school, she relocated to Lorraine, Ohio to pursue a career in nursing. She graduated from Lorraine County Community College certified as an L.P.N. and was employed for three years in this county. Zelma joined the medical staff at the Lanckenau Hospital in Philadelphia, PA and remained a dedicated employee for thirty-nine years until her retirement in June 2011. Zelma was a long time member of the Chi Eta Phi National Nursing Sorority.
